

 Leg Up Farm **Equine Assisted Therapy** \$20,000




Equine Assisted Therapy for Veterans of all ages, filling the disparity gaps in funding that only supports post 9/11 Veterans.

Providing funding for SGB (Stellar Ganglion Block) Injections to significantly reduce symptoms of PTS. Cost is approximately \$2,000 per injection and it is not funded through Veterans Affairs.

 Pennsylvania Furniture Mission **Furnishing Homes for Veterans** \$7,500



 Veteran Memorial Gold Star Healing and Peace Garden **Memorial in Honor of Terry Gendron** \$1,000

Memorial tree and plague in honor of Terry Gendron, Retired Director of York County's Veterans Affairs.

 Catfish for Heroes **New Boat Motor** \$7,500



Provides no cost fishing trips to Veterans as outdoor therapy, giving them a positive outlet from their stressors. The YCVO partnered with Roots for Boots to share the cost of a new boat motor.





Prodigy Spectrum Management (PSM) **Furniture for Personal Care Home** \$5,000

The only VA supported personal care home for Veterans in York County. PSM opened their third home in the fall of 2024, and this was the second \$5,000 grant gifted by the YCVO (the first in 2023). Both grants were used to furnish the homes.

 Veterans Lake Fishing **New Boat Motor** \$2,500



Contributed to a new boat motor needed to provide Veterans and their families experiences through utilizing fishing and communication skills while growing a support system within our community and our family.

 LifePath Christian Ministries **Emergency Shelter for Veterans** \$2,500



Providing food, shelter and a connection to support services for Veterans.

ARPA Funding 2023-2024

In 2023, the YCVO secured a \$225,000 grant from York County as part of the American Rescue Plan (ARPA). Funds were allocated to Glenn Hope Care Farm, Cover Six Canines and the hiring of our first part-time staff member. In addition to reimbursing their expenses and helping to spread the word about their great work, the recipients are required to provide quarterly updates to the YCVO to document their use of the funds in support of Veterans. We anticipate all ARPA funds to be spent by early 2025 for our nonprofits and mid 2025 for our Administrator.

Glenn Hope Care Farm (GHCF)
 Mental Health Support & Farm Skills

Glenn Hope Care Farm offers farm activities to Veterans and their families, including horticulture therapy, animal husbandry, submersion in nature, hiking, fishing, hunting, camping, agricultural classes and special events.

Cover Six Canines
 Service Dogs for Veterans

Assists Veterans with securing and training of service dogs at no cost to the Veteran.

York Revolution 2024 Nonprofit Season Partnership

In 2024, we honored York County Veterans at 63 York Revolution Home Games in this Championship Winning Season. YCVO Board Members and volunteers were joined by our partners in the YORKVET Network



as we raised awareness of available services and fundraised for York County Veterans and their families.

Susan P. Byrnes spoke Opening Day and from that moment onward, we received the highest outreach in donations, volunteers and Veterans looking to connect since our Founding in 2013.

We had special tributes for our Veterans at seven home games including two over Memorial Day Weekend, July 4 and on September 11. All Veterans whose names had been submitted were honored on WellSpan Park's Big Screen. Retired Vice-Admiral Chip Miller "The Air Boss" spoke during Top Gun Night, York County's Director of Veterans Affairs, Kevin Smyers, spoke on September 11 and YCVO Board Member Sherry Decker led Veterans from Harley-Davidson on the field for Super Heroes Night.



We owe a special THANK YOU to our Sponsor, Harley-Davidson Motor Co. Military & Veteran Resource Group for their \$15,000 Grant, which allowed all funds raised during the season to go directly to Veterans. Fundraising at WellSpan Park for our Veterans yielded a net profit of \$13,304.94.
